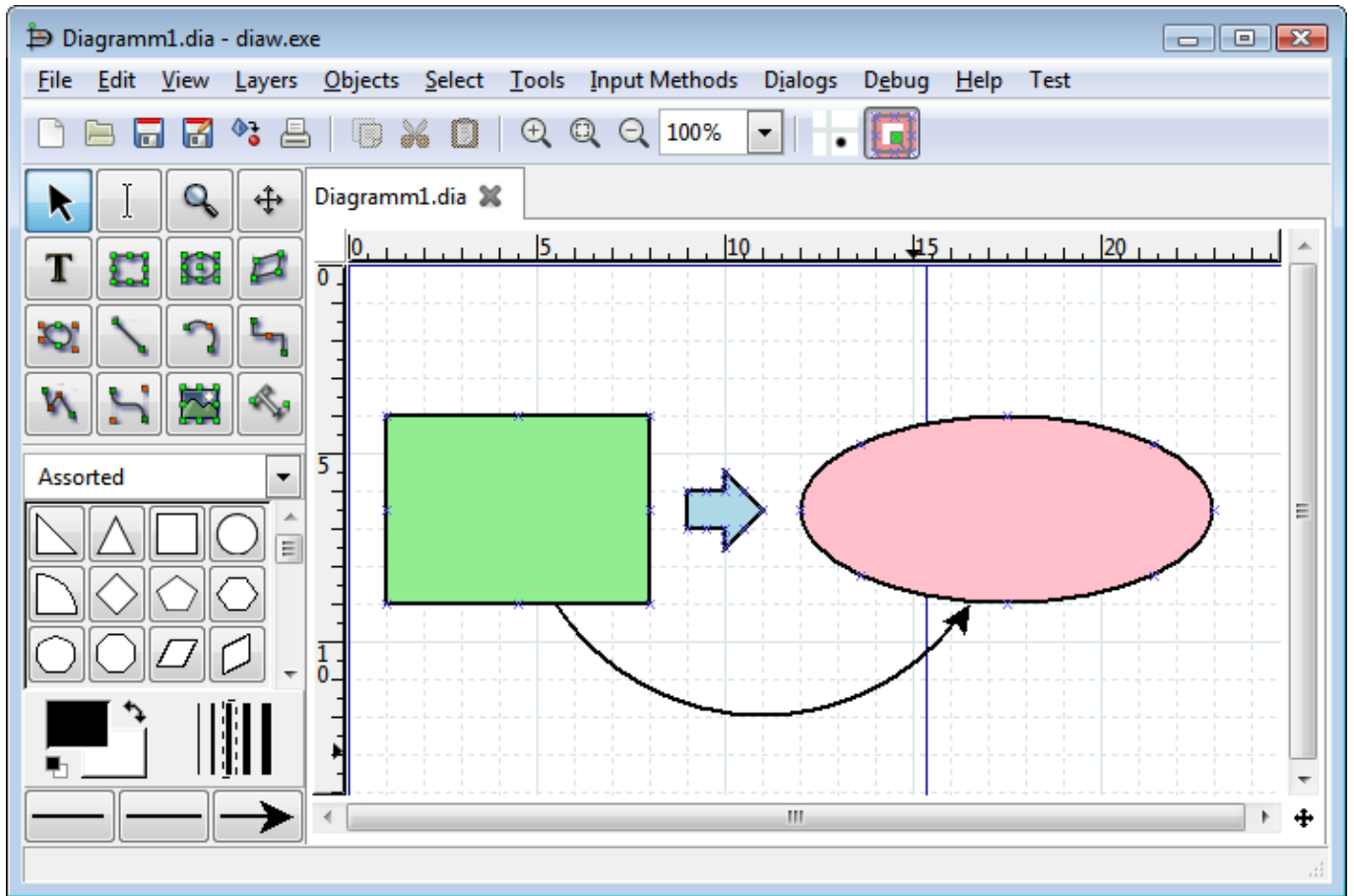

I don't get to convert the received value as datetime I don't know what more to do.. It can take Month as number, but always returns 1 digit, even I use datePart(MM, getdate()) You need to use CONVERT with a style parameter or hack something together with DATEPART or DATENAME.. Your input is in valid datetime format You can use CAST to convert the data type: Date format in sql server 2014 Get via App Store Read this post in our app! All I found is a list of predefined DateFormat that I can choose from, like this As I remember in MySQL (and PostgreSQL too?) you can define your Date Format: Does SQL Server have the same thing? I see people have to write a function to do such thing, does it have a built-in one? I just found the DatePart function.

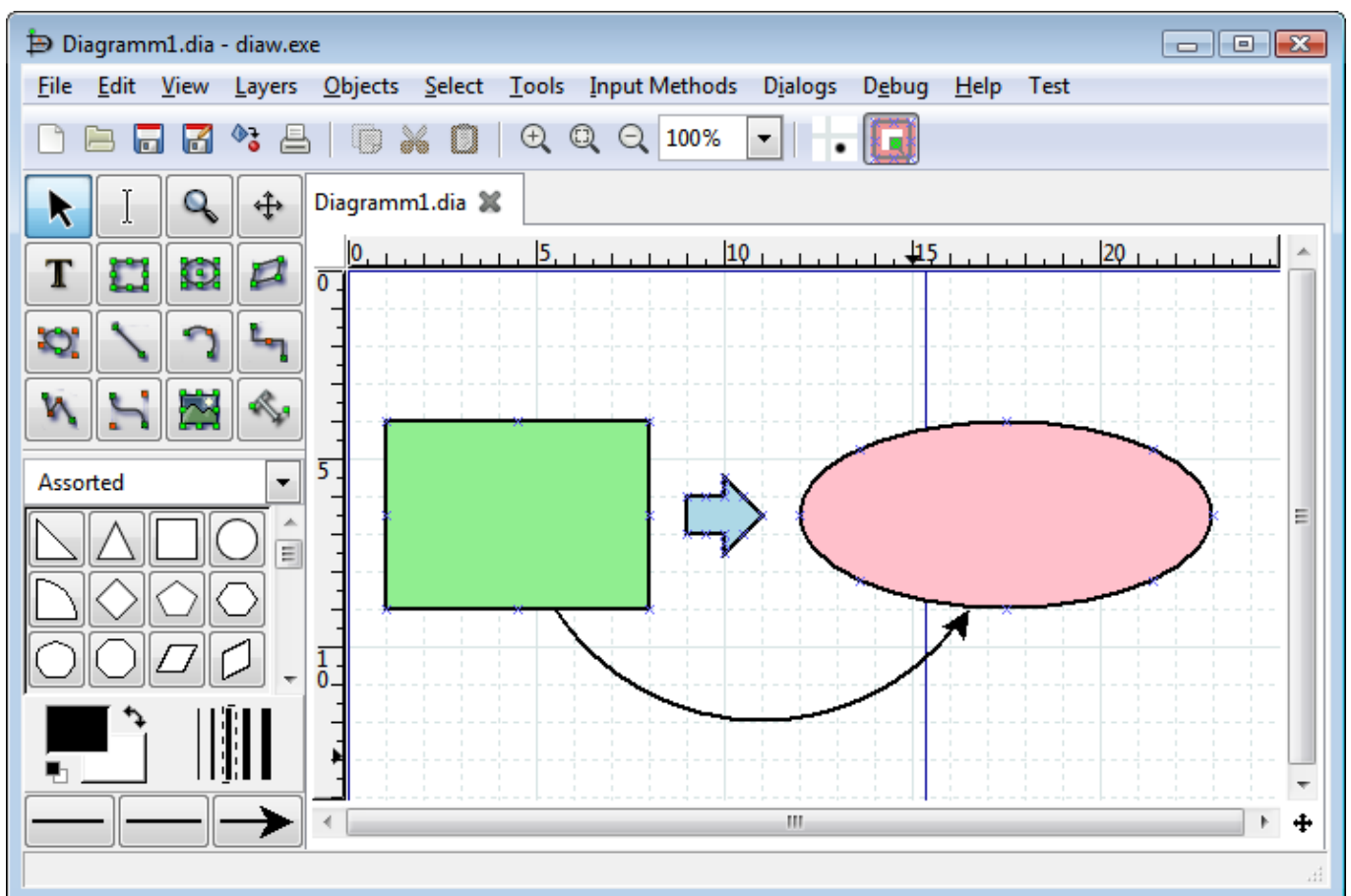
